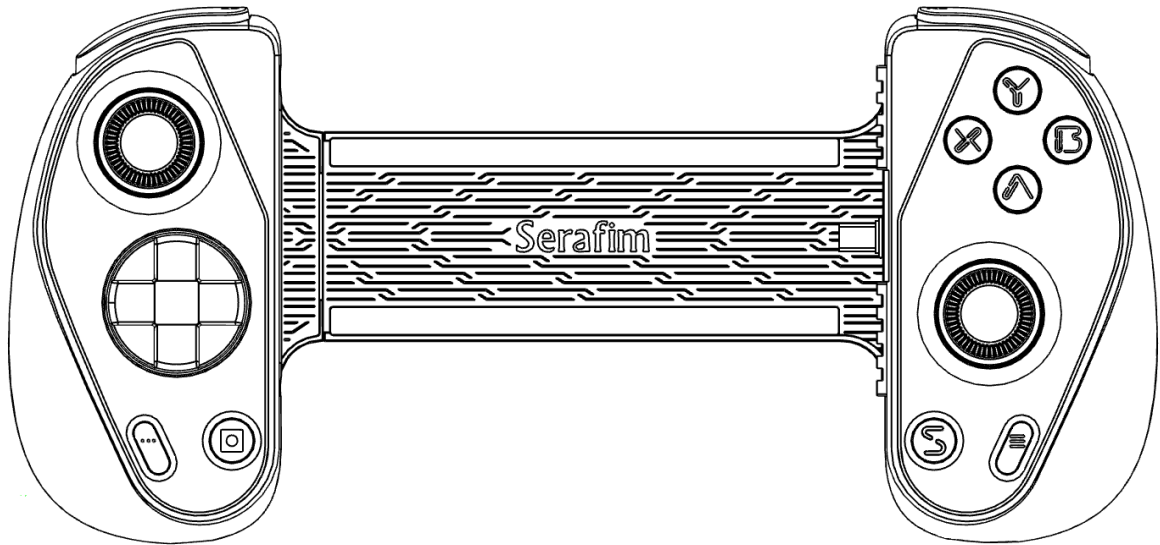

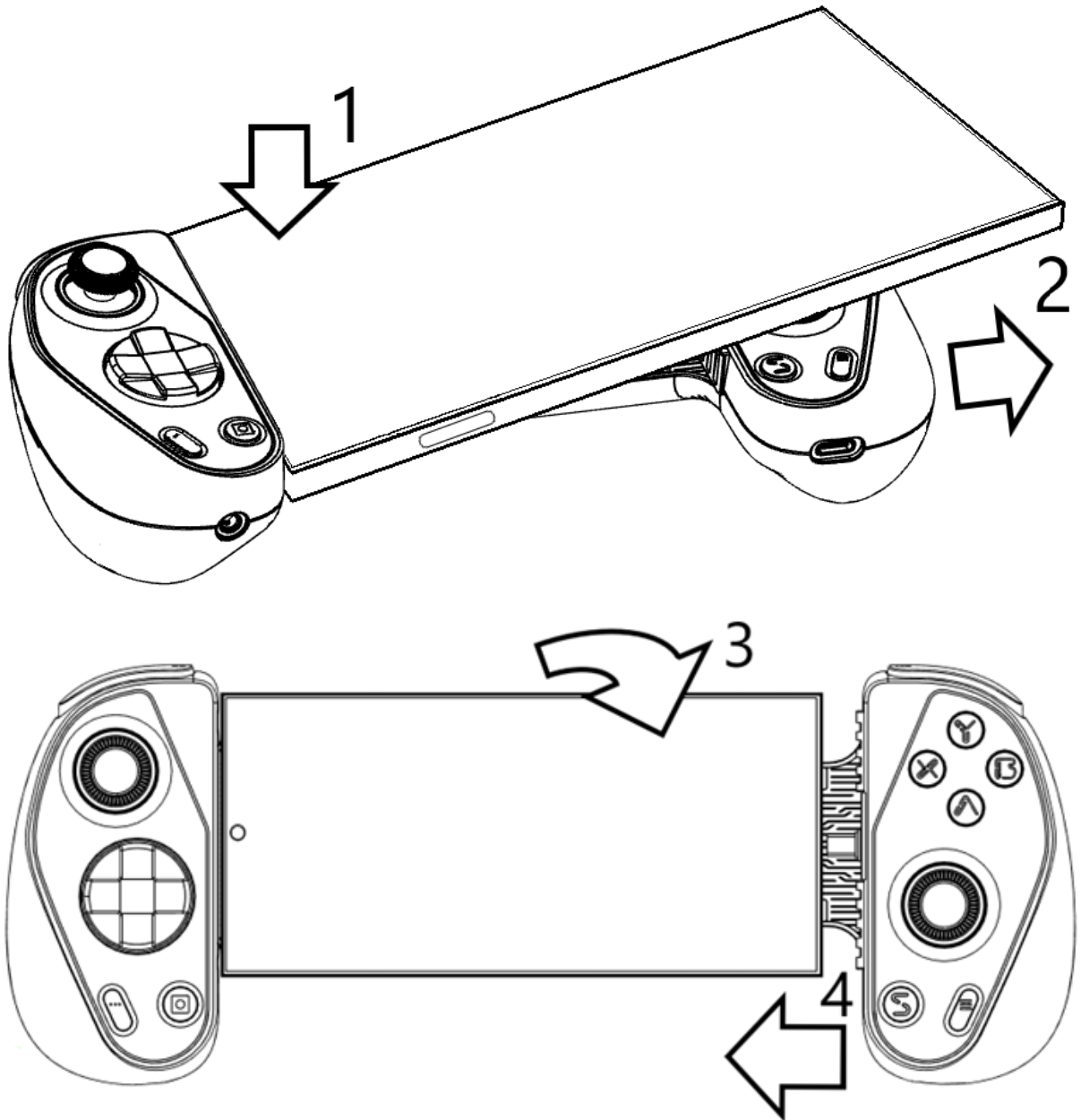

A. Serafim S3 Cloud Gaming Controller

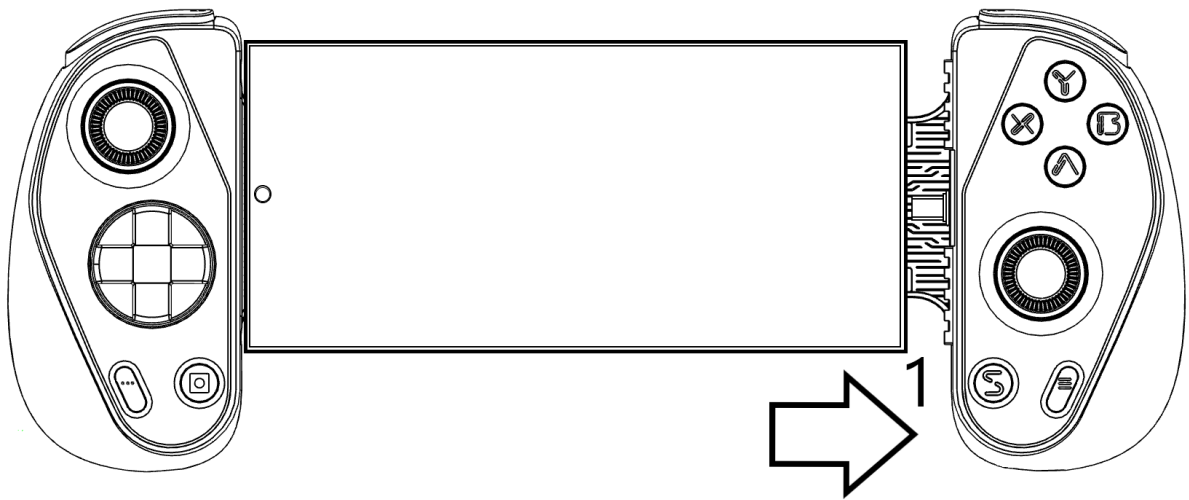
Attach Serafim S3 to a phone

- 1 Align the top of your phone with the left side of the controller.
- 2 Stretch the controller until it fits your phone's length.

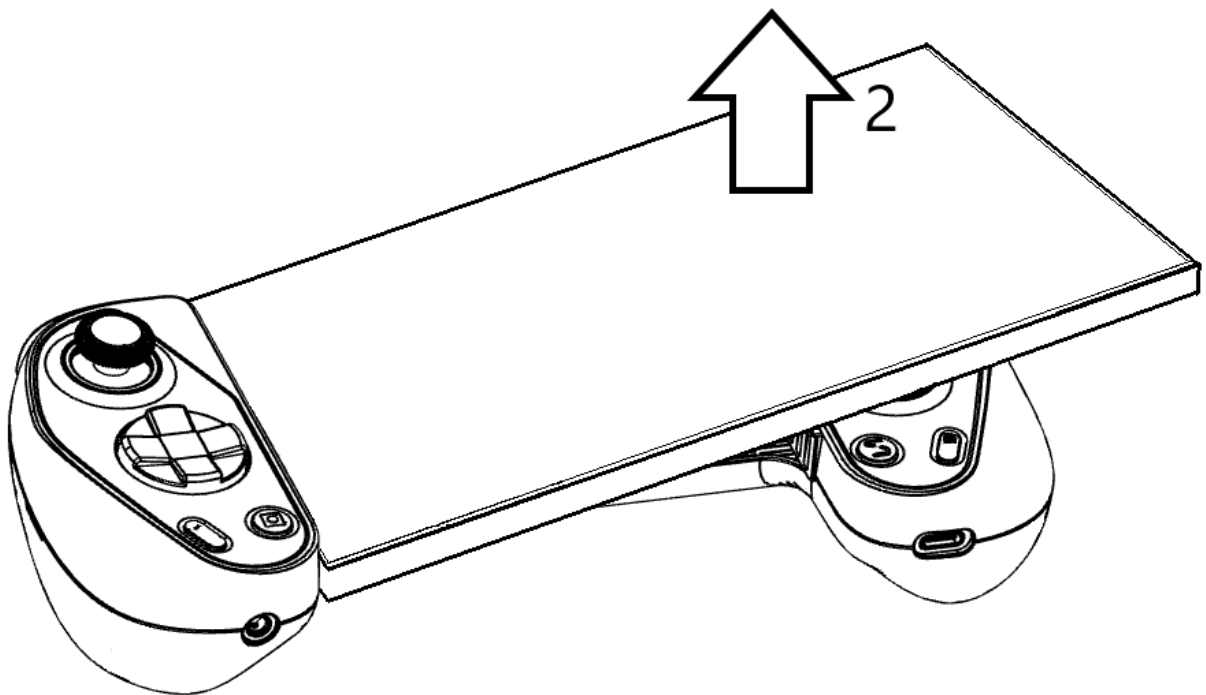


3. Place your phone in the controller.
4. Insert the controller's USB Type-C connector into the corresponding port on your phone.

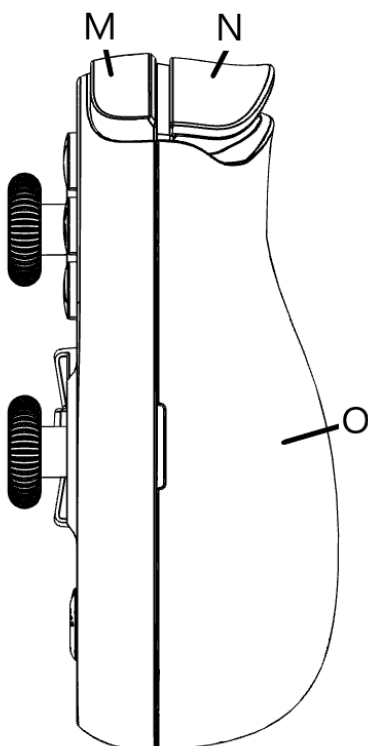
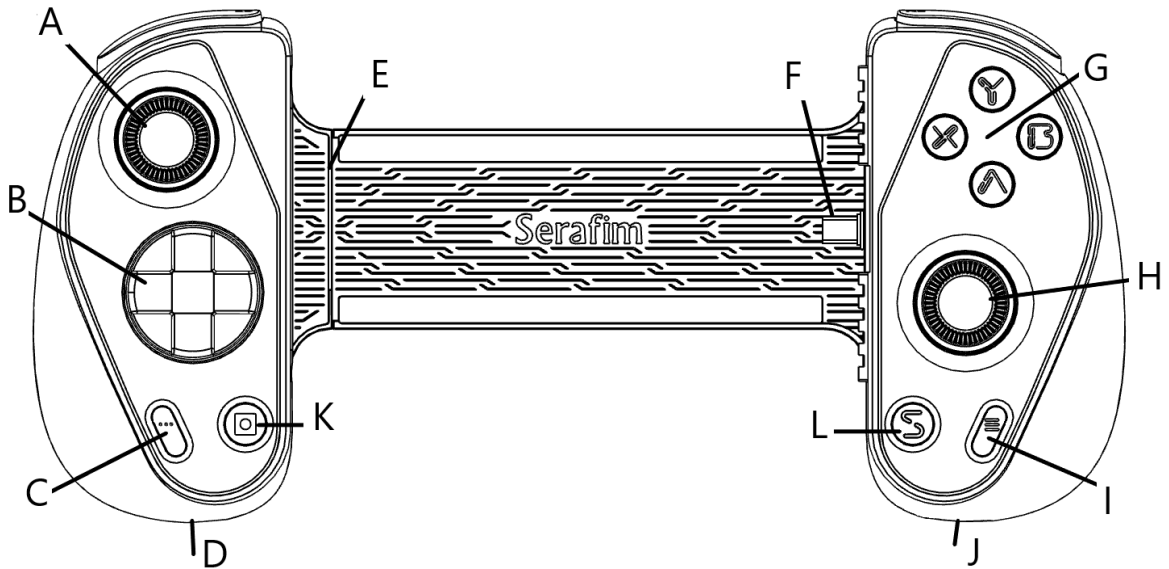
Detach Serafim S3 from a phone



1. Pull the controller apart until the USB connector is completely out of the phone's USB port.
2. Lift the phone up to separate it from the controller.

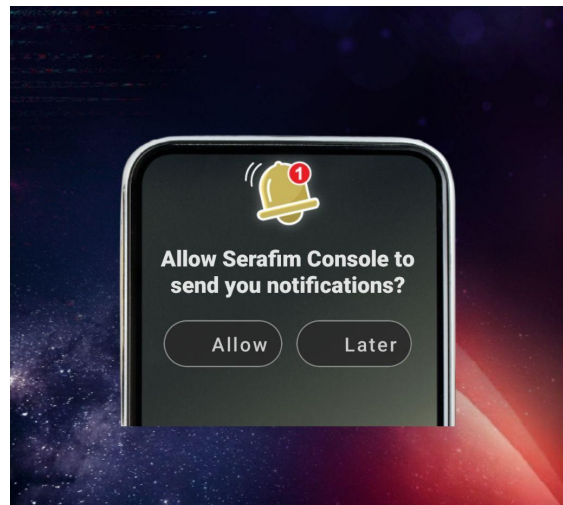

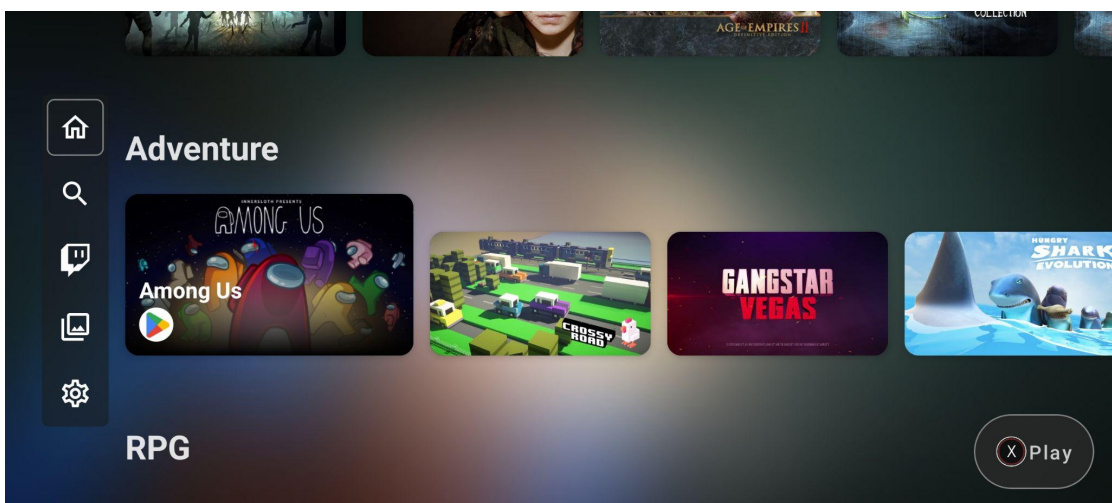
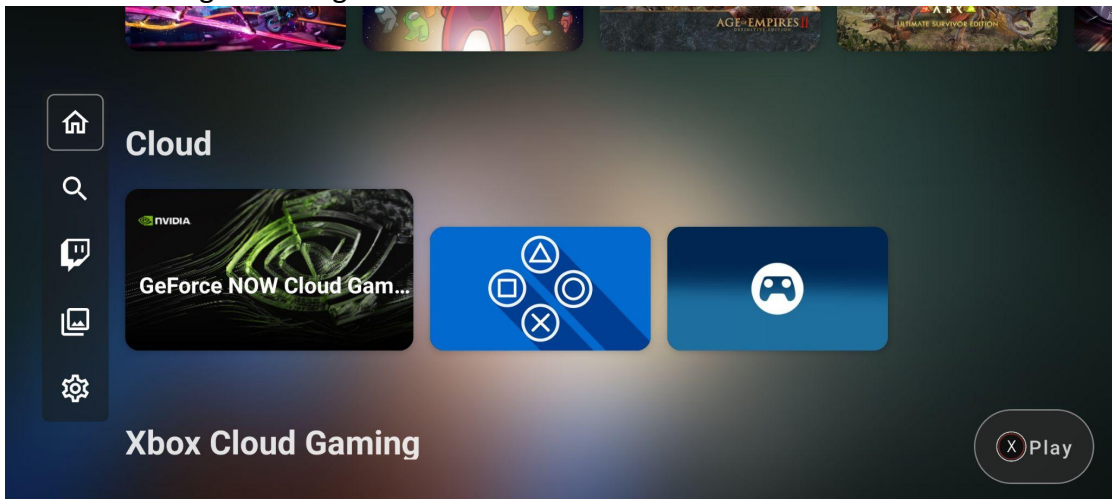
2 Navigation

2.1 Main Screen Overview

The left side icons from top to bottom are Home screen, Search, Twitch live streaming, video editing and sharing feature, Settings. The game list displayed at the top is a list of installed games, with the last played game displayed first.



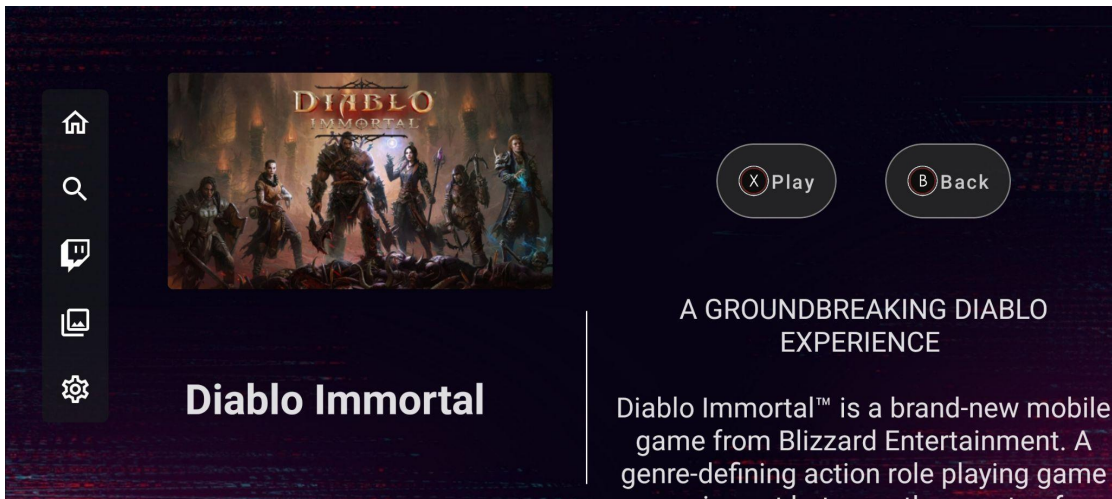
Various game categories in the main screen

Or, press the A button to enter the game introduction screen, then press the X button to enter the game.



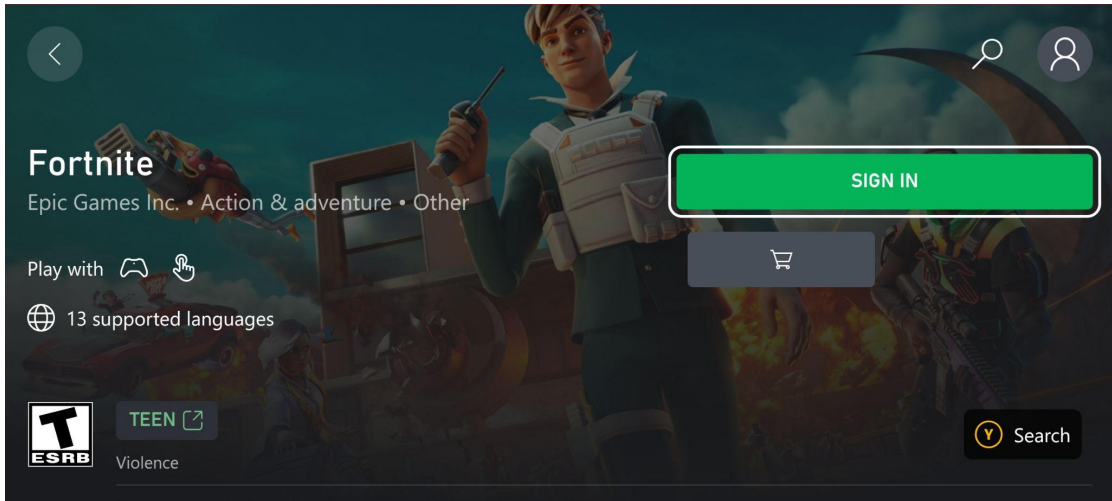
3.1 **Google Play**

3.2 **Xbox Cloud Gaming**

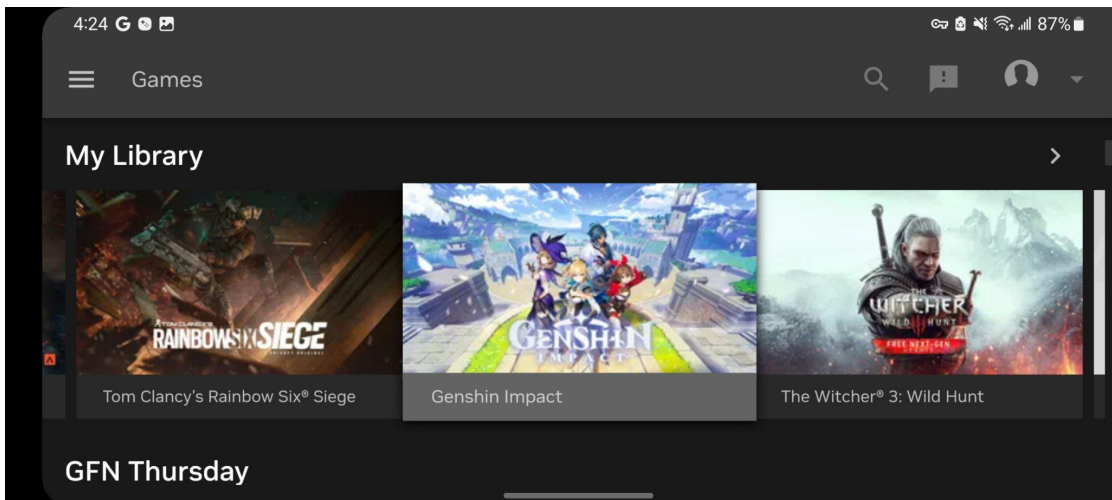

* The smoothness of cloud gaming depends on your current internet speed.

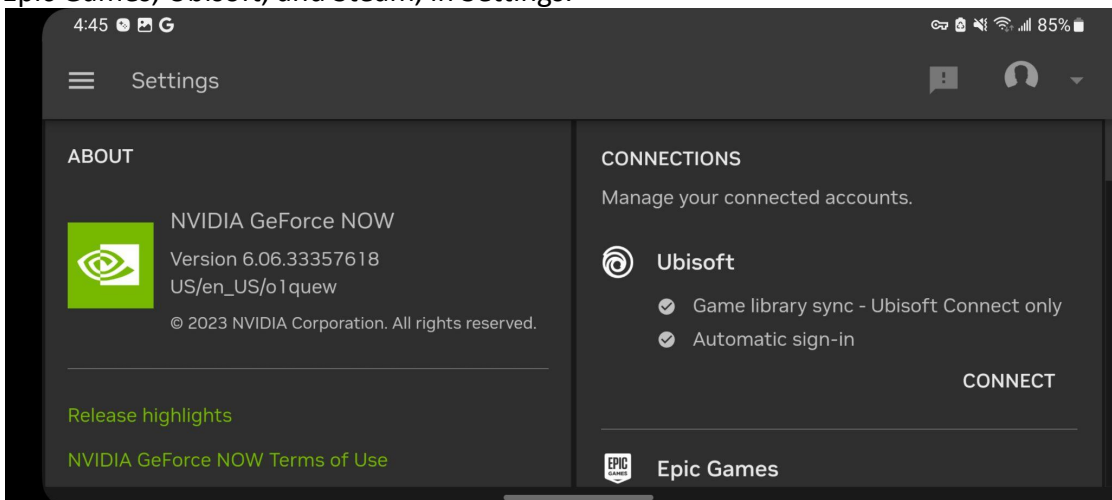


3.3 GeForce Now: Cloud gaming service

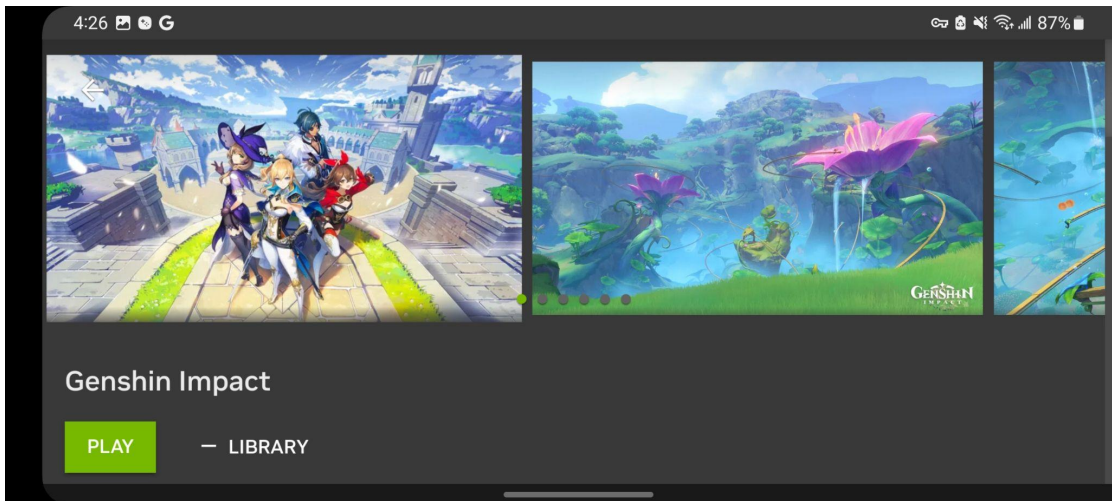
* You must have a GeForce Now subscription to play GeForce Now. To play GeForce Now, simply select the GeForce Now icon in the Cloud section of the main screen.



After logging in to your account, link your existing game accounts, such as Epic Games, Ubisoft, and Steam, in Settings.



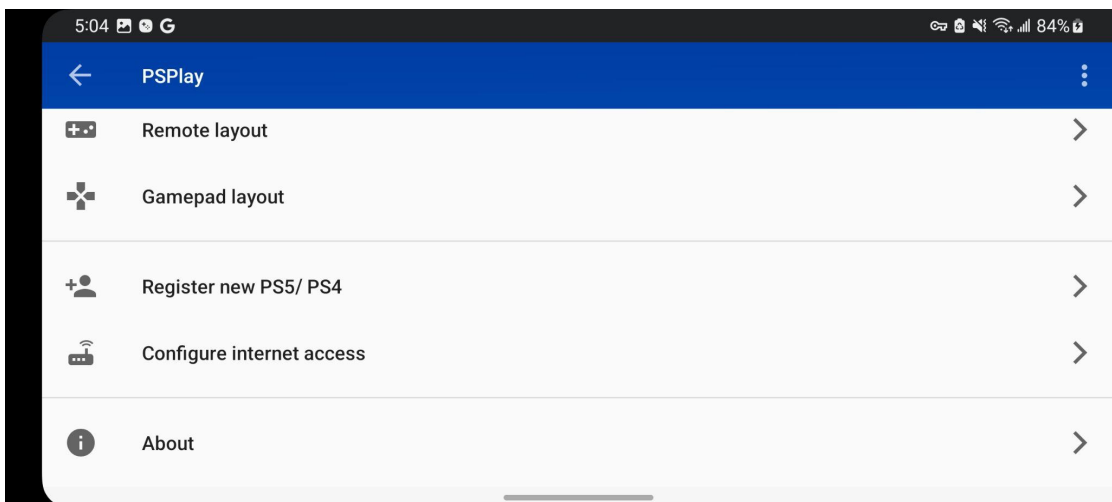
You can then start cloud gaming or play free games on GeForce Now.



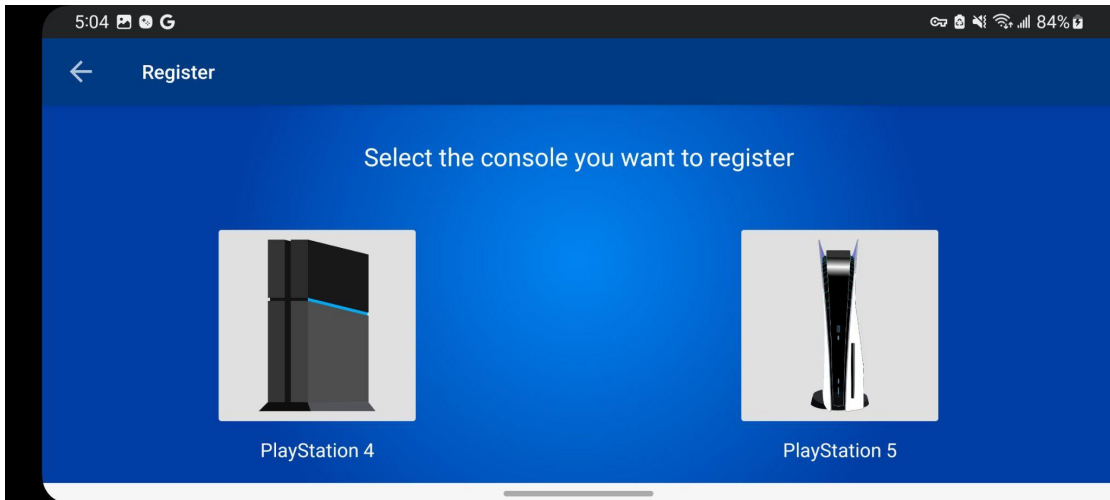
3.4 PlayStation 4/5: Remote Play

* You must have a PlayStation 4 or PlayStation 5 console and a PlayStation Network (PSN) account to play a PlayStation 4 or 5 remotely.

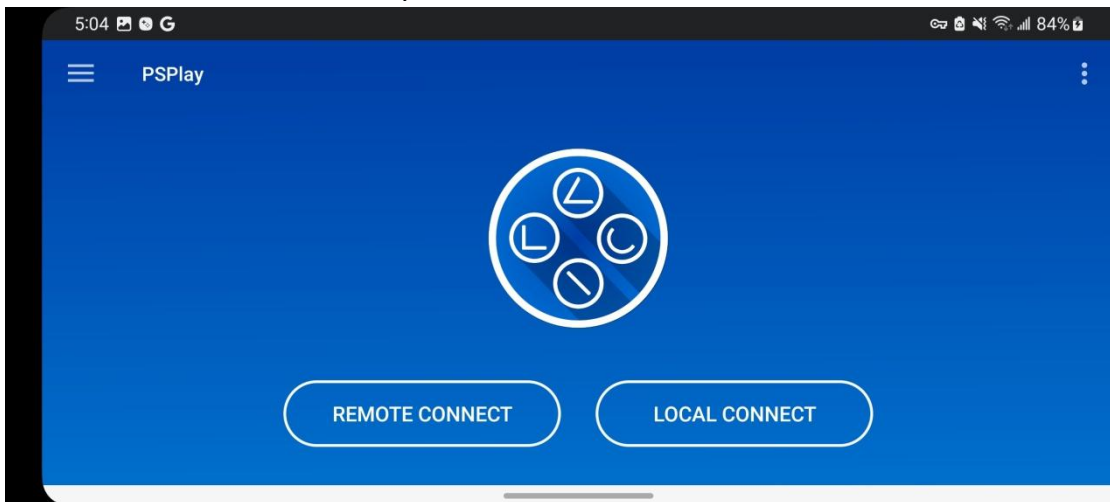
1. Download the PSPlay app from Google Play.
2. Select the PSPlay icon in the Cloud section of the main screen.
3. Log in to your PSN account.



4. Press "Register new PS5/PS4" to bind your PlayStation 5 or 4.



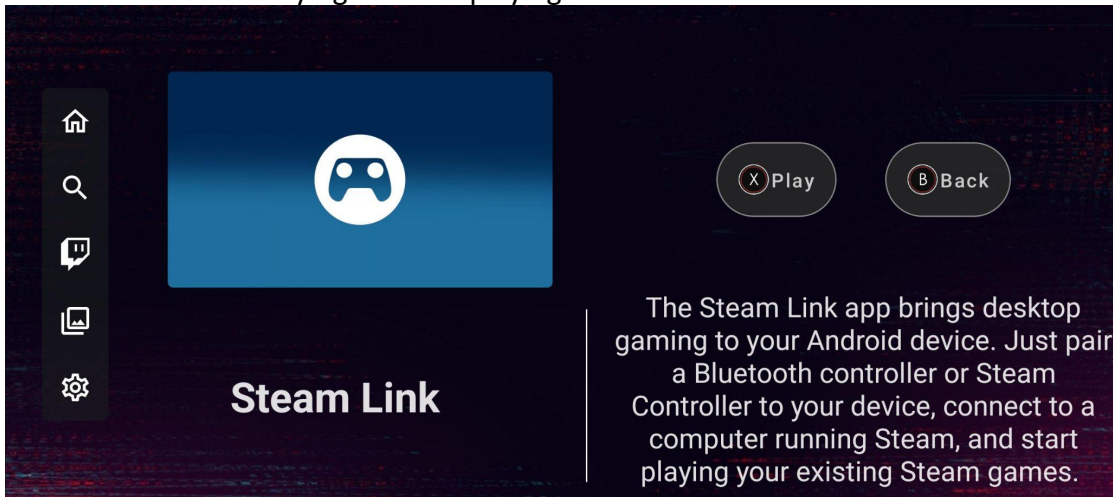
5. Select "Remote Connect" or "Local Connect" to play your game console remotely

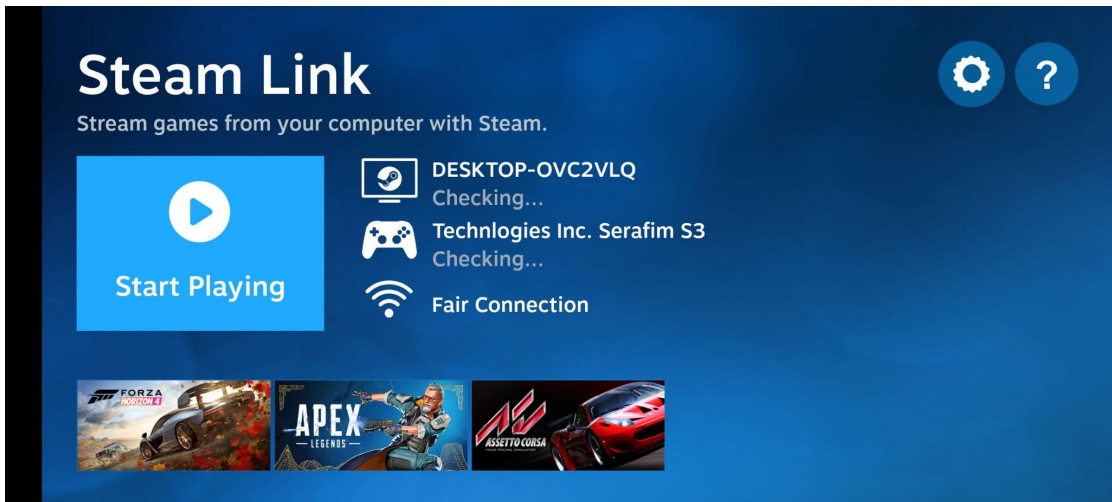


3.5 Steam Link: Cloud Gaming

* You must have a Steam account to use Steam Link.

1. Select the Steam Link icon in the Cloud section of the main screen.
2. Log in to your Steam account.
3. Follow the instructions in the app to set up.
4. Press "Start Playing" to start playing.



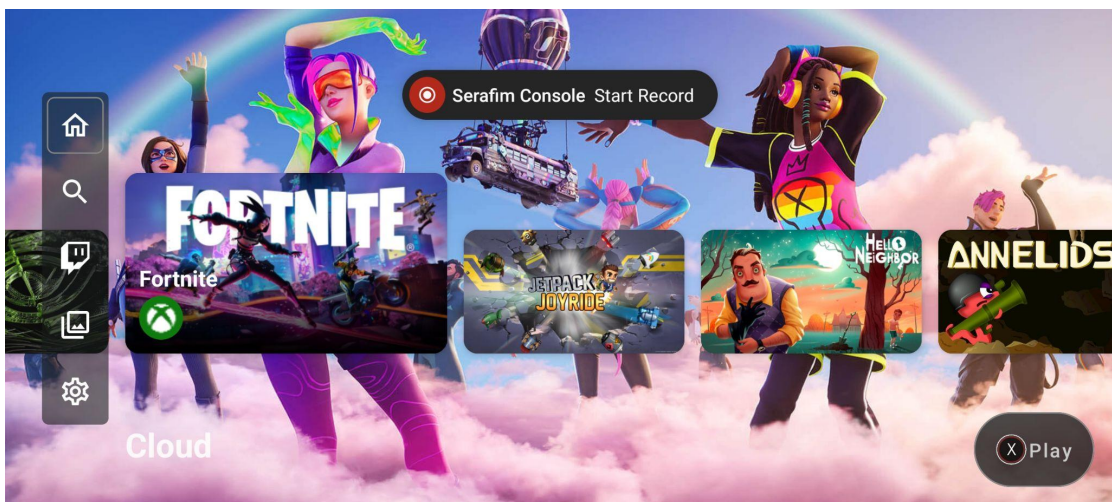


4 Screenshot/Recording and Editing/Sharing Features

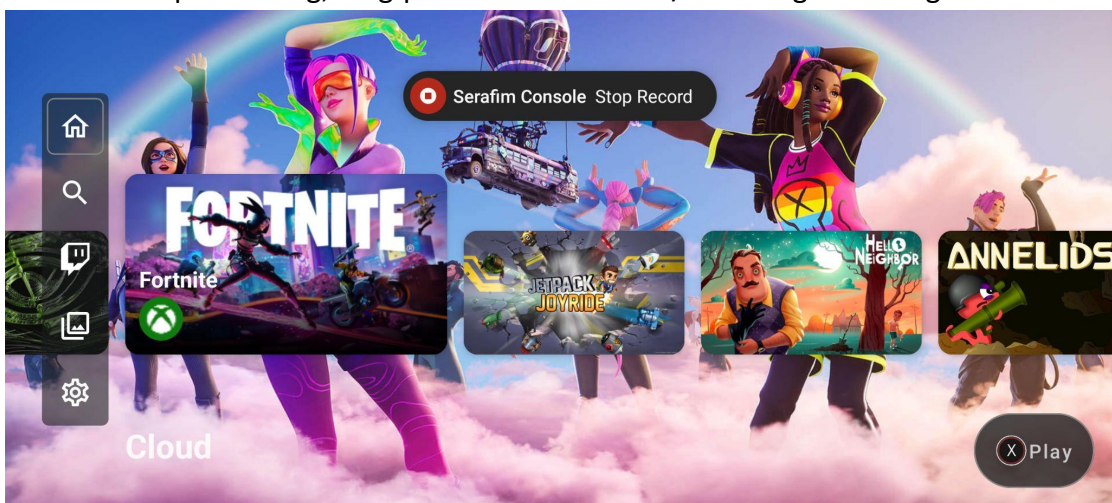
4.1 Screenshot/Recording

To start recording, long-press the screenshot/recording button. A green dot will appear in the top right corner of the screen to indicate that you are recording, and a notification will appear on the phone screen.

* Simultaneous recording and streaming is not currently supported.



To stop recording, long-press the screenshot/recording button again.

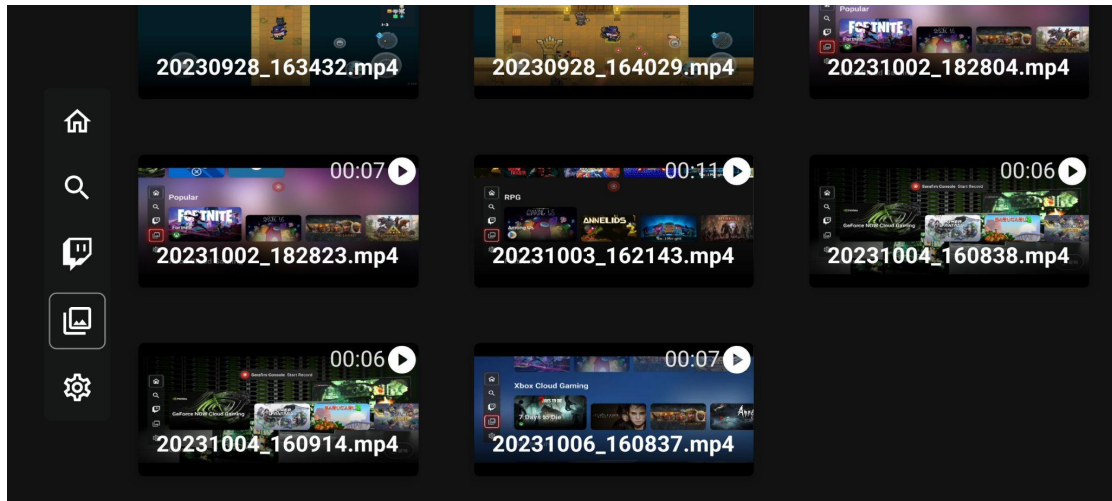


To take a screenshot, simply short-press the screenshot/recording button. Recorded files can be viewed on the video editing and sharing page.

4.2 Editing Recorded Videos

In the video editing and sharing page, select the video you want to edit.

* The latest recorded file is at the bottom of the page.



Press L3 (left joystick) and R3 (right joystick) to move the L3 and R3 in the video, and trim the video to the desired length. Press the A button to trim.

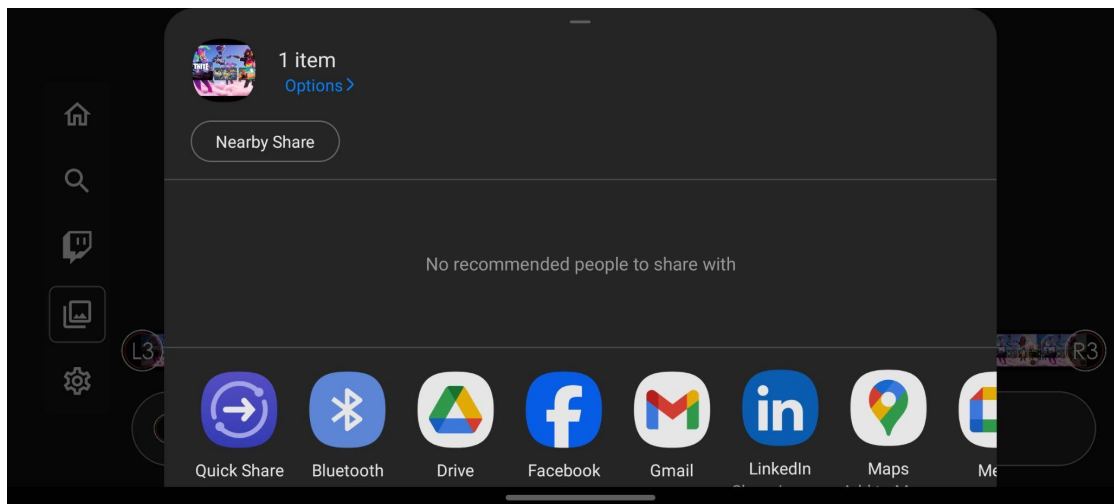
* The trimmed video will automatically be added to the bottom of the recorded file page.



4.3 Sharing Recorded Videos

In the video editing and sharing page, select the video you want to share. Press the Y button to share, and you can share it on various social platforms.

* The social platforms may vary depending on the phone manufacturer.

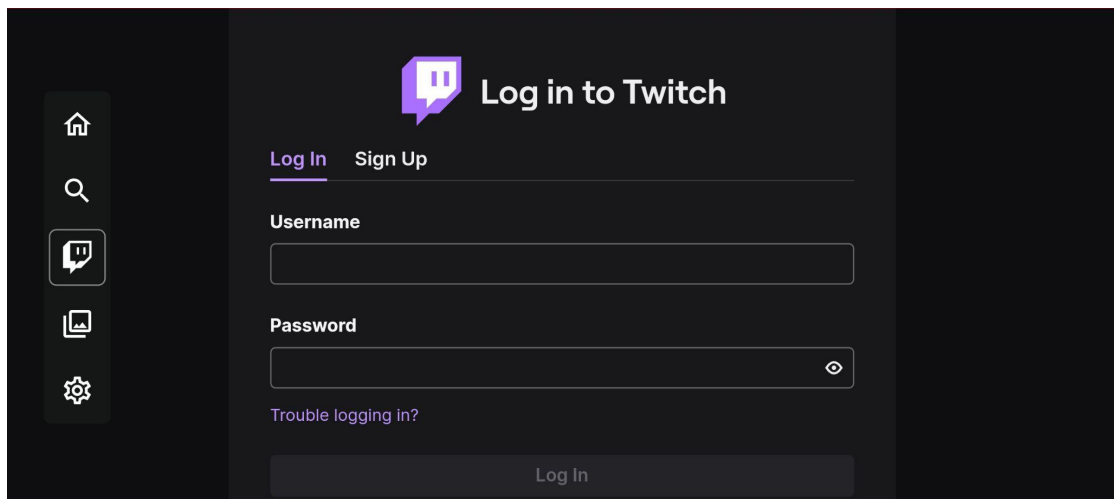


5 Twitch Streaming

To start Twitch streaming, select the Twitch icon on the main page. After logging into your account, you can start streaming gameplay on your phone.

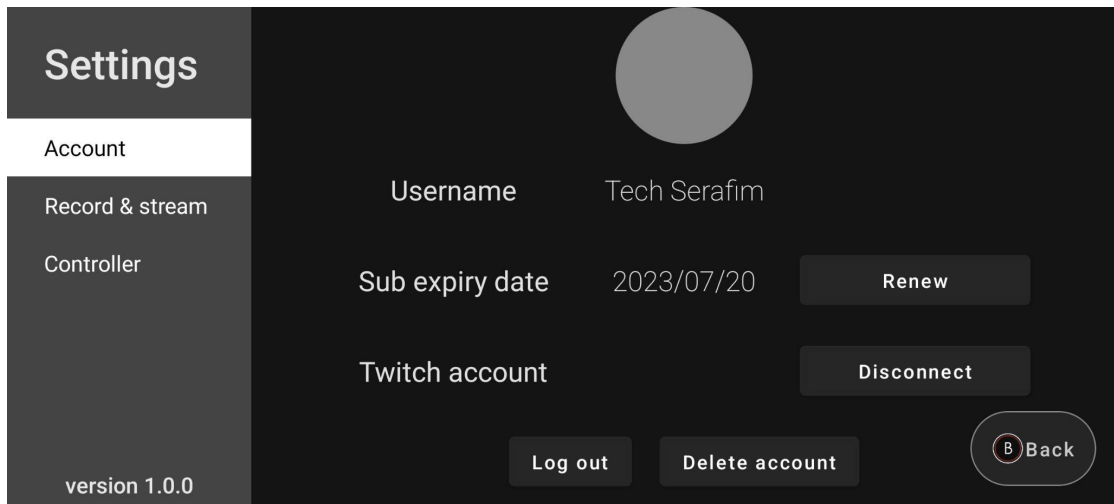
- * A small green dot will appear in the top right corner of the screen to indicate that you are streaming. The green dot will disappear when you are no longer streaming.

- * Simultaneous recording and streaming is not currently supported.

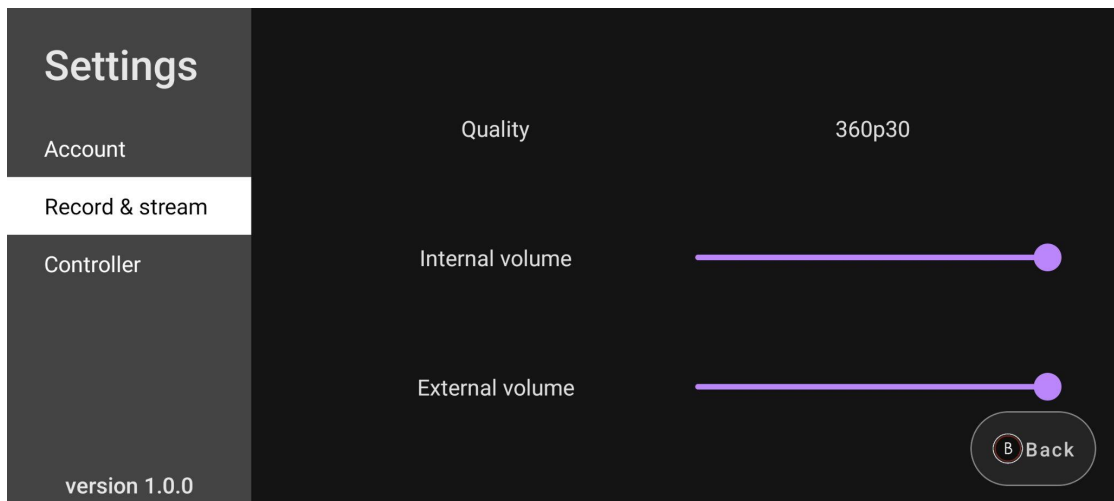


6 Miscellaneous settings

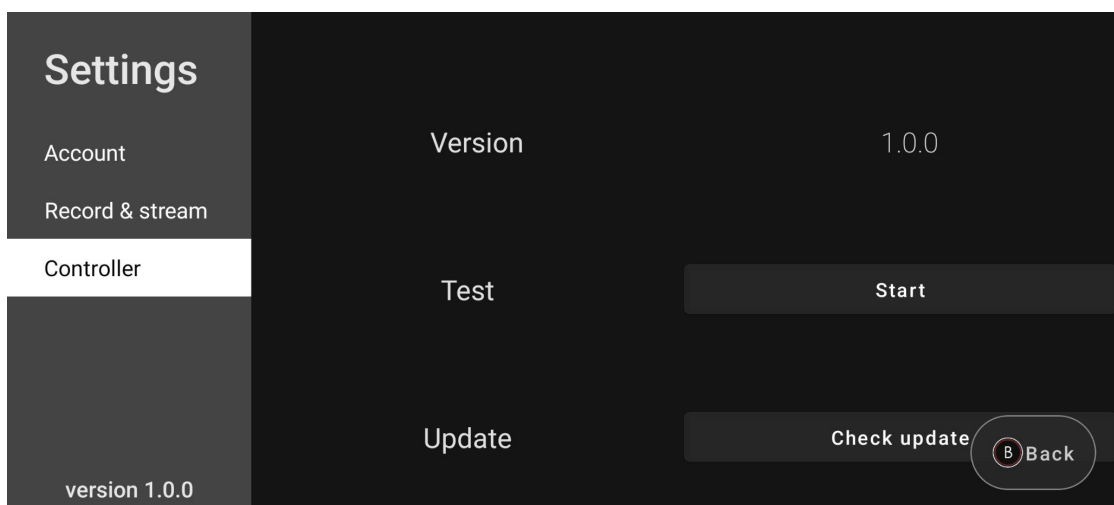
On the main page, select the Settings icon. The Account page allows you to log in or switch accounts.



The Record & Stream page allows you to set the video quality and volume.



The Controller page provides features to test the functionality of buttons and update the firmware.



The Button Test page allows you to test the buttons and joysticks to make sure they are working properly. To exit the ButtonTest page, press and hold the Serafim button.

PC and Tablet Connection Instructions

Computer:

1. Connect a USB-C cable to a USB port on a computer that supports Windows 7 or higher.
2. The computer and tablet will automatically connect.

Tablet:

1. Connect a USB-C cable to the USB-C port on a tablet that supports Android 8.0 or higher.
2. The computer and tablet will automatically connect.

Frequently asked questions

Q1. Are the L2 and R2 triggers pressure-sensitive?

A1: Yes, the L2 and R2 triggers are pressure-sensitive hall effect triggers.

Q2. What is the approximate latency when connecting the controller?

A2: The controller uses a wired connection to the phone, with a latency of less than 3 milliseconds.

Q3. Can I connect it to my computer to play games?

A3: Yes, you can connect it to a Windows computer to play games.

Q4. Does it support emulators like PPSSPP?

A4: Yes, it does.

Q5. What thickness of phone case can I use?

A5: We recommend using a phone case with a thickness of 3mm or less.

Q6. What systems does the controller app support?

A6: The dedicated Serafim Console app currently supports Android 8.0 and above. Smartphones come with a USB Type-C port and OTG (On-The-Go) support. Please note that if your phone is not listed below, it doesn't necessarily mean that it is not compatible with the Serafim S3 Gamepad. It simply means that we are still working hard to confirm its compatibility. As we confirm compatibility with more models, we will continue to update this list.
